Programs & Services for Children & Families:

Adoption Services include opportunities for adoption of US and international children.

The Counseling Center provides diagnostic assessments, counseling and treatment of persons with issues of mental health, substance abuse, anxiety, or psychotic disorders.

Group Residential Care and Treatment are offered from campuses in Beckley and Burlington. The program serves up to 63 youth, ages 8 to 18. Services include individual and group therapy, educational services at on-ground schools, and a spiritual life program.

Right From the Start Services are provided to at-risk expectant mothers and newborn infants from the agency's offices in Beckley and Keyser.

Social Necessity Services are provided to families in need of reunification with children in foster care.

Specialized Foster Family Care Services are offered from four office sites. This program serves infants, children and youth in need of care outside of their family of origin through foster homes.

Student Intervention is a truancy prevention program designed to work with school-aged children, adolescents and their families.

Troubling Trends Among West Virginia Children (2002)

- Approximately 25% of children live in poverty
- More than 1/3 of poor children are abused or neglected
- About 10% of teens drop out of high school
- Over 70% of 4th-graders are below grade level in reading & math
- About 13,000 WV children were addicted to drugs or alcohol
